GAMES TO BE PLAYED UNDER WORLD 8-BALL RULES.

FORMAT: SINGLES FRAMES – 4 or 5 Players per team, Captains choice. SCOTCH DOUBLES – 2 Frames

TEAM FRAME: 1 Frame with 4 Players in each Team (Captains to specify which Players)

SCOTCH DOUBLES : Toss for break, alternate breaks thereafter. EXAMPLE OF SCOTCH DOUBLES PLAY –

Player 1 of team breaks, if ball potted play passes to Player 2, this continues until a pot is missed or a foul is committed, then Player 1 of opposing team takes control of the table, if a ball is potted play passes to Player 2 of opposing team and so on until a pot is missed, the 8-ball is potted, or a foul is committed. If play passes to opposite team at any time then the next player in numerical sequence takes control of the table.

TEAM FRAME: As per Scotch Doubles, except 4 players from each side form the teams and play sequentially.

WHEN THE BEATLES PLAYED THE TELETUBBIES (An idiot's guide to Scotch Doubles, by an idiot)

The Sheet was filled in as above and the match started - Sir P. McCartney won the toss and the Captains Frame, but Tinky Winky got his revenge by winning Frame 1 of the Singles.

John , George and Ringo won the next three, but Yoko (always there or there abouts) lost the last Singles to an unstoppable Tinky Winky, bringing the score to 3 -2 in favour of The Beatles after the Singles frames.

McCartney & Starr played Tinky Winky & Dipsy in Frame 1 of the Scotch Doubles, McCartney broke off but failed to pot so Tinky Winky took control of the table and slammed in a long shot to the baulk pocket, passing play to Dipsy who doubled one into the middle. Play passed back to Tinky Winky, who missed a sitter, handing control of the table to Starr . Starr and McCartney took turns knocking in the balls including a stunning black by McCartney to win the frame.

The second Scotch Doubles frame, between Lennon/Harrison and Po/Lala was a scrappy affair, Po broke off and sent the white off the table giving Lennon and Harrison two shots. Lennon potted, Harrison potted, Lennon missed and Harrison potted on the second visit, but an off-form Lennon missed again to let the Teletubbies back in. Lala, playing his first shot of the frame five minutes after the break, had an awful 'kick', missed the pot and handed control straight back to Harrison. But there then followed a series of misses where control was passed from team to team – Harrison missed, Po missed, Lennon missed, Lala missed (again) Harrison missed, Po missed and at last Lennon knocked a ball in that started a Lennon, Harrison run out with Harrison potting the black.

Overall score (excluding the Captains Frame) 5 – 2 to The Beatles after the Scotch Doubles.

In the Team Frame eight of the players were in one frame of pool Yoko standing in for Lennon (who had left the venue complaining of lead poisoning). Yoko broke off, potting a ball, Harrison potted (the Rigor Mortis in his arm not impeding his cuing) McCartney missed and the Teletubbies wiped them off the table with a Tinky Winky, Dipsy, Lala, Po, Tinky Winky, Dipsy, Lala, Po combination clearance proving that just because you can't reach the table and are covered in fur you can still beat two old musicians, two dead musicians and a Chinese slapper. It's a shame the run of good pool came so late in the match for the Teletubbies, they still lost overall 6 – 3 (Captains Frame included)

Unfortunately, the game score was voided and both teams were fined for not signing the sheet (Macca said something about Ebay, and Tinky Winky can't write)..
